Article I Name and Purpose

Section A. The name of this organization shall be Tau Sigma Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc.

Section B. The mission of Tau Sigma is to provide economic, political, educational, and cultural awareness for the campus of Florida Gulf Coast University.

We are committed to the purpose and objectives of our national organization, the moral and spiritual values of our founders, the preservation of the African American family, the diligence of public service, and the encouragement of academic excellence.

To this end, the chapter will strive to create an atmosphere of unity that will enhance and enrich the communities and reinvigorate our bond to Delta Sigma Theta and our commitment to public service.

Section C. The Tau Sigma Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. shall comply with all local, state and federal laws, as well as all Florida Gulf Coast University regulations, policies and procedures. Such compliance includes the Student Code of Conduct and the Student Organization Handbook.

Article II Membership

Section A. Tau Sigma is comprised of active members of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. that are undergraduate women who attend Florida Gulf Coast University and are in good financial status with the sorority.

Section B. Tau Sigma shall not haze any prospective member for the purpose of admission into or affiliation with the organization. Members of Tau Sigma are free to leave or dissociate without fear of retribution or harassment.

Section C. Tau Sigma, in order to comply with the University's commitment to non-discrimination, no discrimination shall be made on the basis of gender, race, color, creed, age, religion, disability, national origin, marital status, sexual orientation, parental status or veteran status.

Section A. The officers of the Tau Sigma shall be President, Vice President, Recording/Corresponding Secretary, Treasurer and Financial Secretary.

Section B. Officers shall be elected during a regular sorority meeting in April by ballot voting.

Section C. In order to comply with the University's Student Activities Eligibility Regulation, (FGCU-PR4.005), effective Fall 2010, Tau Sigma, undergraduate student leaders will be registered for at least nine (9) credits each regular semester, and enrolled in a credit bearing course in either summer term A, B or C, and maintain a minimum 2.25 cumulative FGCU GPA.

Article IV **Amendments**

Section A. Any member of this organization may suggest amendments to this Constitution that follows the guidelines in the chapter's Policies and Procedure.
